Hello Campaign and Bingo Initiative Feedback

We are thrilled to share the overwhelmingly positive feedback we received from both our staff and students regarding the recent implementation of the Hello Campaign and Bingo Initiative. This initiative aimed to foster a more connected and engaged workplace environment by encouraging staff members to strike up conversations with colleagues, and for students to interact with peers they may not regularly interact with, all while incorporating an element of fun through bingo.

As part of the Hello Campaign, we introduced the Bingo Initiative, where each staff member received a bingo card featuring the names of their colleagues. The students received a blank card where they needed to get their cards signed off by their peers. The objective was simple, to encourage communication and interaction among team members. We also included exciting prizes to further incentivize participation.

The response from our staff was truly remarkable. We observed a significant increase in engagement and interaction throughout the office, with employees actively seeking out conversations with new colleagues. The atmosphere was filled with energy and enthusiasm, as individuals bonded over shared interests and experiences.
